RULES CLINIC

Colin will be conducting a rules clinic on Tuesday, May 2nd for WSWGC members. There will be 2 sessions (30 min each) prior to our scheduled tee times. A few of the rules that will be covered are how to take relief from a cart path and relief options from a penalty area. The first clinic will be from 8:15 to 8:45 and the second clinic from 8:45 until 9:15 (the same information will be covered in both sessions). Stay tuned for more details...

WEDGE CLINIC

A Cleveland Golf representative (with Colin's assistance) will be conducting a wedge clinic on Tues, **June 6th** for WSWGC members. There will be 2 sessions available (7:45-8:45 and 8:45-9:45). The cost for the clinic will be \$169.00 and each participant will get a **FREE Cleveland Wedge** (valued at \$169). If you don't know the basics of how to select the perfect wedge for you then this wedge clinic is exactly what you need. Remember, well over half of your shots are taken from 50 yards and in so if you were to have a custom club in your bag; it should be a wedge. The expert club fitter from Cleveland can answer any questions and fit you with the best wedge. Come learn:

- How bounce is your friend.
- What loft should I use?
- How many degrees should I have between my clubs?

Sign-up and pay in the pro-shop before MAY 6th (after that date, Colin will open the clinic to WSGC members to fill any open spots).
