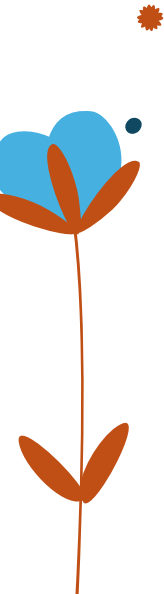
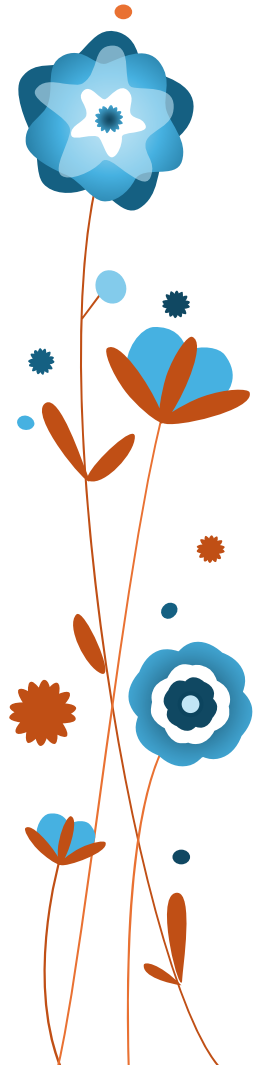


June 2024 Newsletter

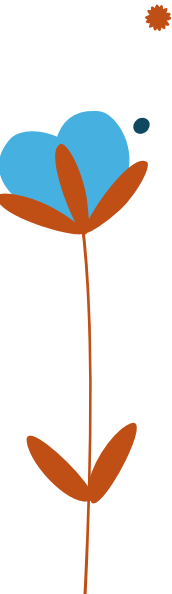
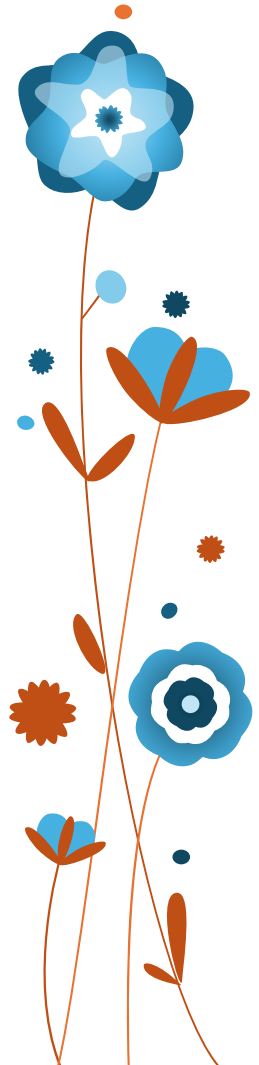


MIDDLE OF THE SEASON




There have now been enough WSWG events for people to qualify for the club championship. There are still enough events left, to allow you to qualify (you need 5) in June and July in case you haven't done so already.

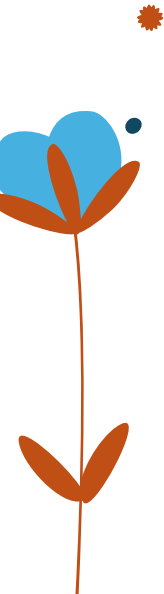
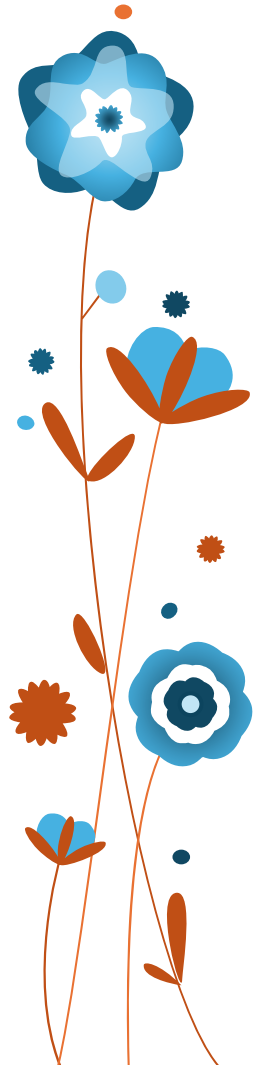
WSWGC 2024 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

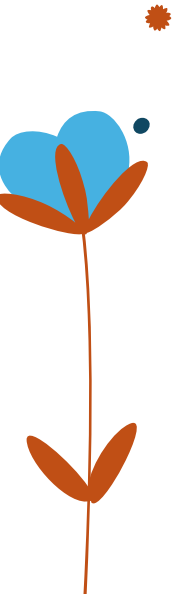
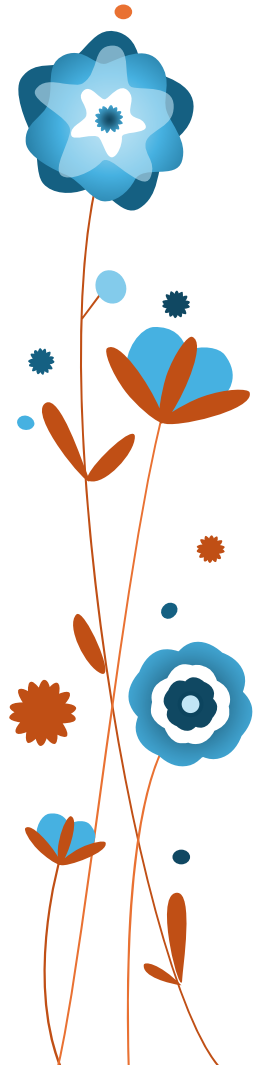
