



2026 Weekly Competition Procedures

1. Weekly Competition Play:

- Weekly Competition starts on Tuesday and ends on Saturday of each week.
 - Weekly Competition includes: Weekly game of the week and Weekly Low Gross of the Field.
- Each week of competition play presents all members the opportunity to win a small prize in a competition between the members participating that week. Weekly Competition is optional. To be eligible for the competition prizes members must:
 - Follow the rules of golf during play.
 - Have a current, valid handicap through GHIN. Handicaps are capped at 54.0 for weekly competitions.
 - Play from the Tees of your choice: Gold, Purple, Green, White (or Blue or Black if you so desire!).
 - Players will be flighted using their Course Handicap. Course Handicaps will be based on the Tees played. The number of Flights will depend on the number of players for that week.
 - Turn in a Scorecard.
 - Prizes are awarded weekly in the form of credit, also known as “book money” at the West Seattle Golf Course Pro Shop and can be used to purchase merchandise or a Power Cart rental but cannot be used to purchase food, beverages, or greens fees, and have no cash value.
 - **New for 2026:** While all members are welcome to play on both Tuesday and Saturday, only your first round of the week counts towards all competitions, i.e. Weekly Competition, Weekly Low Gross of the Field, Birdies, Eccis and Chip-Ins. For example, if you play on Tuesday and Saturday, only Tuesday’s scorecard is eligible; Saturday’s scorecard is not.
 - **Season Long Competitions: Birdies, ECCI’s, Chip-Ins, Low Gross and Low Net:** All **GROSS** Birdies and **NET** ECCI’s will be calculated electronically based on Weekly Competition scorecards turned in. Only Chip-Ins must be posted manually on the competition board.

2. Scorecard Instructions:

- Use the regular West Seattle Golf Course scorecard.
- Print your **First** and **Last** name clearly on the first line and record your **GROSS** hole-by-hole scores. (It’s important to add your last name. We have a large club with multiple members with the same first name.)
- On the second line, print which tees you played (Purple, Gold, Green, White, etc.).

- On the remaining line(s), print the name of any other player(s) whose score(s) you are keeping, the Tee they are playing and record their **GROSS** hole-by-hole scores.
3. Reconcile and Certify Scores:
- At the end of the round, reconcile the scorecard with the player(s) whose score(s) you are keeping.
 - Players should review each other's scores to ensure accuracy.
 - Once reconciled, ask the other player(s) to sign the card. We need at least two signatures, a "Scorer" and an "Attester".
4. Submit Scorecards:
- Drop the scorecard into the designated box in the locker room.
 - **IMPORTANT**, before dropping off your scorecard, either take a photo or make a copy of your scores so you remember it when you post to GHIN.
 - To be eligible to win a prize for weekly competitions, you **must** post your scores to the GHIN app or GHIN.com by midnight on the day of play.
 - **End of the Year Prizes:** All Birdies, ECCI's, Chip-Ins, Low Gross and Low Net of the season will be awarded at the end of the year banquet.
5. Weekly Competition Committee (WCC) Takes it From There:
- The WCC will collect the scorecards and manually enter your hole-by-hole scores electronically into the Golf Genius software.
 - The WCC has pre-programmed all competitions in the Golf Genius software. The Golf Genius software will do all the math and figuring for us.
