

WSWGC Board Meeting Minutes Friday, 2/20/2026 - 2:00 PM

Old Business:

Weekly Competition Terms and Procedures - At the January meeting it was decided that each member will have one opportunity to participate in the weekly competition, even if they play both Tuesday and Saturday. Players who play both days will submit their scorecard from Tuesday for the weekly competition. The issue today is about the additional competitions including birdies, eccies, chip ins, low gross and net gross. It was moved, seconded and approved unanimously to apply the same rule of only being eligible for these competitions 1 time each week on the first round played during WSWG official competitions - ie Tuesday and Saturday. If a member plays both Tuesday and Saturday - the Tuesday round is submitted for competition. The hole in one contest is a separate activity and not included in the once weekly rule.

New Business :

The budget allocations have been set up based on review of funds utilized from previous seasons. At the end of the 2025 season, there ended up being a large sum available for the Year End Awards. Wendy suggested the Board consider reallocating some of those funds to other categories where funding has been tight. After discussion, it was decided to reallocate 3% from Year End Awards to the Social budget - increasing that allocation to 10%. It was also decided to move an additional 3% from Year End Awards to the Weekly Competition budget - increasing that allocation to 37%.

It moved, seconded and voted unanimously to adopt the new allocations for the 2026 Budget and to approve the proposed budget for the year.

There was considerable discussion regarding funding for Saturday tournaments. Wendy shared the results of a member survey from several years ago and suggested it may be time to resurvey the Saturday players. Several ideas were shared regarding how funds might be reallocated. In the end it was decided to revisit the issue at a later meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:14.
